

RUNNER ON FIRST BASE

- 1 — HOMERUN over left field fence
 2 — TRIPLE along right field foul line
 3 — DOUBLE to center; runner scores; (S out at home A-CF PO-C; *scores)
 4 — TRIPLE to left
 5 — HOMERUN over right center field fence
 6 — DOUBLE over first; runner to third (F scores) *any runner scores
 7 — SINGLE to right; runner to third; batter to second on throw to third

 17 — SINGLE to right; runner to second; runner to third and batter to second on fumble; E-RF
 18 — First on error; runner to third; E-SS
 19 — SINGLE to third; runner to second

 21 — First and second on error; runner to third; A-SS E-1B (F scores)
 22 — First on error; runner to second; catcher fumbles bunt; E-C; †credit batter with sacrifice if less than two are out

 15 — Hit by pitcher; batter to first; runner to second
 16 — First on error; runner to second; E-CF; (F to third) *any runner to third
 17 — SINGLE to right; runner to third; batter to second on throw to third; (F scores)
 18 — First on error; runner to third; E-SS
 SINGLE to third; runner to second
 20 — First on error; runner to third; E-2B
 21 — First and second on error; runner to third; A-SS E-1B

 16 — Fly out runner holds; (F to 2nd); PO-CF
 17 — SINGLE to right; runner out at third; A-RF PO-3B batter to second on throw to third
 18 — Out at first; runner to second; A-SS PO-1B
 19 — SINGLE to third; runner to second
 20 — First on error; runner to third; E-2B
 21 — First and second on error; runner to third; A-SS E-1B
 22 — First on error; runner to second; catcher fumbles bunt; E-C; †credit batter with sacrifice if less than two are out
 23 — Runner out stealing and ejected from game for disputing umpire's decision; A-C PO-SS
 24 — Double play; A-SS PO-2B A-2B PO-1B

† Indicates a sacrifice. Do not charge batter with time at bat.

A — Assist; PO — Putout; E — Error;

F.C. — Fielder's Choice.

On double plays when two are already out score the first listed Assist and Put out only.

BASE RUNNING SYMBOLS (F) AND (S)

Some players' cards may bear (F) or (S) symbols before their fielding positions. When such players are base runners, be sure to follow any (F) or (S) base running modifications that appear on the playing board UNLESS the base runner has been "coached" to do otherwise, as explained elsewhere on these playing boards.

PITCHING SYMBOLS (W) (X) (Y) (Z)

Certain pitcher's cards may have one or two of these symbols after their fielding ratings. When such pitchers are on the mound ignore the regular play entirely and score only as follows when these symbols appear after the board number: W — base on balls; X — strikeout, PO-C; Y — strikeout, PO-C; Z — Ball — roll dice for same batter again.

Pitcher's cards with symbol (*) beside pitching grade letter may be used as RELIEF PITCHERS ONLY. If this symbol (*) appears after their names on the line-up sheet, they should be used very seldom as starters.
