

RUNNERS ON SECOND AND THIRD BASES —Defensive team manager must call position of infield: “Deep” or “In”

- 1 — HOMERUN over center field fence
 2 — TRIPLE to extreme left field
 3 — DOUBLE to deep center; runners score; batter out trying for third; A-CF A-2B PO-3B
 4 — HOMERUN over left field fence
 5 — TRIPLE to deep left
 6 — DOUBLE to right; clears the bases
 7 — SINGLE to left center; runners score; batter to second on throw home

11 — SINGLE to left; runners advance one base; (*both runners score); batter steals second on second pitch to next batter; 1 & 1 on batter.

- 12 — Strike out; PO-C
 13 — Strike out; PO-C
 14 — Base on balls; filling the bases
 15 — SINGLE to left; runners advance one base; other runner scores & batter to 2nd on error; E-LF
 16 — SINGLE to center; one runner scores; other scores and batter to second on wild throw; E-CF
 17 — SINGLE to right; one runner scores; other out at home; A-RF PO-C; batter to second on throw home (F safe at home)
 18 — First on error; runners hold; E-SS; *runners advance one base, F on 2nd scores
 19 — SINGLE thru third; runners advance one base (F on 2nd scores)
 20 — First on error; runners advance one base; E-2B
 21 — Hit by pitcher; filling the bases
 22 — SINGLE — runner on second hit by batted ball; other holds third; PO-SS
 23 — Triple play — line drive; PO-CF A-CF PO-3B A-3B PO-2B; centerfielder makes shoestring catch
 24 — High fly out; runners hold; PO-3B
 25 — Double play — line drive; runner doubled off second; other holds third; PO-1B A-1B PO-SS
 26 — C — SINGLE thru second; both runners score
 D — Out at first on ground hit to second baseman; runners advance one base; A-2B PO-1B
 27 — Out at first; runners hold; A-3B PO-1B
 28 — C — Out at first; runners hold; A-SS PO-1B
 D — Out at first; runners advance one base; A-SS PO-1B
 29 — Out at first; runners hold; A-P PO-1B
 30 — Fly out; runner on third scores; other holds; PO-LF
 31 — Fly out; runners advance one base; PO-CF
 32 — Fly out; runners hold; PO-RF
 33 — Pop fly out; runners hold; PO-3B
 34 — High fly out; runners hold; PO-SS
 35 — Foul out; PO-1B (W-base on balls)
 36 — Passed ball; runners advance one base
 37 — SINGLE — beats out bunt; runners advance one base
 38 — Strike out; catcher drops third strike; batter out at first; A-C PO-1B; runners advance one base
 39 — Pop fly out; runners advance one base; PO-SS; shortstop and left fielder collide and are injured; shortstop unable to play next two games; LF out for four games
 40 — C — First and second on error; runners score; E-SS
 D — Out at first; runners advance one base; A-SS PO-1B
 41 — Balk; runners advance one base

FIELDING TWO

- 12 — Strike out; PO-C
 13 — Strike out; PO-C
 14 — Base on balls; filling the bases
 15 — SINGLE to left; runners advance one base; batter to second on throw home
 16 — SINGLE to center; one runner scores; other scores and batter to second on wild throw; E-CF
 17 — SINGLE to right; one runner scores; other out at home; A-RF PO-C; batter to second on throw home (F safe at home)
 18 — First on error; runners hold; E-SS; *runners advance one base
 19 — SINGLE thru third; runners advance one base
 20 — First on error; runners advance one base; E-2B
 21 — Hit by pitcher; filling the bases
 22 — SINGLE — runner on second hit by batted ball; other holds third; PO-SS
 23 — Triple play — left fielder makes shoestring catch; PO-LF A-LF PO-3B A-3B PO-2B
 24 — Double play; foul out, back of first; runner out trying for home; other runner to third; PO-1B A-1B PO-C
 25 — Double play— line drive; runner doubled off second; other holds third; PO-2B A-2B PO-SS
 26 — C — Safe at first; F.C; runner out at home; other to third; A-2B A-C PO-3B; batter to second on rundown
 D — Out at first; runners advance one base; A-2B PO-1B
 27 — Out at first; runners hold; A-3B PO-1B
 28 — C — SINGLE thru short; both runners score
 D — Batter out at first on ground hit to shortstop; runners advance one base; A-SS PO-1B
 29 — Out at first; runners hold; A-P PO-1B
 30 — Fly out; runners hold; PO-LF
 31 — Fly out; runners hold; PO-CF
 32 — Fly out; runner on third scores; other holds; PO-RF (F on 2nd goes to 3rd)
 33 — High fly out; runners hold; PO-3B
 34 — Pop fly out; runners hold; PO-SS
 35 — Foul out; PO-1B (W-base on balls)
 36 — Passed ball; runners advance one base
 37 — SINGLE — line drive hits third baseman who is injured, out for three games; runners advance one base
 38 — Strike out; catcher drops third strike; batter out at first; A-C PO-1B; runners advance one base
 39 — Pop fly out; runners advance one base; PO-SS; shortstop and left fielder collide and are injured; shortstop unable to play next three games; LF out for two games
 40 — C — First on error; runners score, E-2B
 D — Out at first; runners advance one base; A-2B PO-1B
 41 — Balk; runners advance one base

FIELDING ONE

- 12 — Double play; fly out; runner out at home; other to third; PO-LF A-LF PO-C
 13 — Strike out; PO-C
 14 — Base on balls; filling the bases
 15 — First on error; E-LF; runners advance one base; batter to second on throw home; *Both runners score
 16 — Fly out to deep center field; PO-CF; both runners advance one base after the catch
 17 — SINGLE to right; one runner scores; other out at home; A-RF PO-C; batter to second on throw home (F safe at home)
 18 — Pop up fly out; PO-SS; runners hold
 19 — SINGLE thru third; runners advance one base
 20 — Pop up fly out; PO-2B; runners hold
 21 — Hit by pitcher; filling the bases
 22 — SINGLE — runner on second hit by batted ball; other holds third; PO-SS
 23 — Triple play; right fielder makes shoestring catch; PO-RF A-RF PO-2B A-2B PO-3B
 24 — Double play; foul out, back of first; runner out trying for home; other runner to third; PO-2B A-2B PO-C
 25 — Double play— line drive; runner doubled off second; other holds third; PO-1B A-1B PO-SS
 26 — C — SINGLE thru second; runners advance one base
 D — Batter out at first on ground hit to second baseman; runners advance one base; A-2B PO-1B
 27 — Out at first; runners hold; A-3B PO-1B
 28 — C — Out at first; runners hold; A-SS PO-1B
 D — Out at first; runners advance one base; A-SS PO-1B
 29 — Out at first; runners hold; A-P PO-1B
 30 — Fly out; runners hold; PO-LF
 31 — Fly out; one scores; other holds; PO-CF
 32 — Fly out; runners hold; PO-RF
 33 — Pop fly out; runners hold; PO-3B
 34 — High fly out; runners hold; PO-SS
 35 — Foul out; PO-1B (W-base on balls)
 36 — Passed ball; runners advance one base
 37 — SINGLE beats out infield hit and spikes first baseman who is out for four games; runners advance one base
 38 — Strike out; catcher drops third strike; batter out at first; A-C PO-1B; runners advance one base
 39 — Pop fly out; runners advance one base; PO-SS; shortstop and left fielder collide and are injured; shortstop unable to play remainder of game; left fielder continues
 40 — Fly out; PO-RF; runners advance one base after catch (S on 3rd out at home A-RF PO-C; DP)
 41 — Balk; runners advance one base

“C” indicates the scoring when the infield is playing in for the runner at home plate; “D” indicates the scoring when the infield is playing deep.
 * INDICATES THE SCORING WHEN TWO ARE OUT. DP —Double play
