- 21—Out at first; runner scores A-P PO-1B†
- 22—Safe at first on F.C.; runner scores on error; A-P E-C
- 23—Double play; strike out; runner out at home; Both PO-C
- 24—Batter safe on F.C.; runner out at home; A-3B A-C PO-SS; batter to second on rundown
- 25—Double play; pop up bunt; PO-C A-C PO-SS; shortstop covers third
- 26—Foul strike
- 27—Foul strike
- 28—Out at first; runner scores; A-1B PO-2B†
- 29—Strike—batter misses attempt to bunt; runner returns safely to third
- 30—Foul strike
- 31—Out at first; runner scores; A-P PO-1B†
- 32—Out at first; runner scores; A-3B PO-1B†
- 33—Foul strike
- 34—Foul strike
- 35—Batter safe on F.C.; runner out at home; A-1B A-C A-3B PO-C; batter to second on rundown
- 36—Passed ball; runner scores
- 37—Catcher picks runner off third; A-C PO-3B
- 38—Runner steals home
- 39—Strike—runner caught off 3rd in rundown; A-C A-SS PO-SS
