

RUNNERS ON FIRST AND SECOND BASES

- 14—Base on balls; fills the bases (Z-ball)
- 15—SINGLE to left; one runner scores; other to third and batter to second on throw home
- 16—First on error; runner out at home; other to third; batter to second on throw home; E-CF A-CF PO-C; *one runner scores; other out at third; E-CF A-CF PO-3B
- 17—Hit by pitcher; fills the bases
- 18—SINGLE thru short; runners advance two bases (S on 1st out at 3rd A-CF PO-3B)
- 19—1st on error; runners advance 2 bases; E-3B
- 20—First on error; filling the bases; E-2B
- 21—First on error; filling the bases; A-3B E-1B
- 22—First on error; filling the bases; E-P
- 23—Ball —catcher disputes umpire's decision and is ejected for remainder of the game
- 24—Double play; one runner to third; other out at second; A-2B PO-SS A-SS PO-1B
- 25—Double play; one runner to third; other out at second; A-SS PO-2B A-2B PO-1B
- 26—Infield fly; PO-2B
- 27—Out at first; runners advance one base; A-3B PO-1B (X-strikeout; PO-C)

FIELDING TWO

- 12—Double play; A-SS PO-2B A-2B PO-1B; runner to third (W-base on balls)

- 15—SINGLE to left; one runner scores; other to third and batter to second on throw home.
- 16—Fly out; runners advance one base; PO-CF

FIELDING ONE

- 12—Double play; A-3B PO-2B A-2B PO-1B; runner to third (W-base on balls)
- 13—Strikeout; PO-C
- 14—Base on balls; fills the bases (Z-ball)
- 15—SINGLE to left; one runner scores; other to third; batter out trying for second; A-LF A-1B PO-2B
- 16—First on error; runner out at home; other to third; batter to second on throw home; E-CF A-CF PO-C; *one runner scores; other out at third; E-CF A-CF PO-3B
- 17—Hit by pitcher; fills the bases
- 18—SINGLE thru short; runners advance two bases (S on 1st out at 3rd A-CF PO-3B)
- 19—1st on error; runners advance 2 bases; E-3B
- 20—First on error; filling the bases; E-2B
- 21—Out at first; runners advance one base; A-3B PO-1B
- 22—First on error; filling the bases; E-P
- 23—Foul —strike; catcher injured by foul tip and is unable to play in next three games.
- 24—Double play; one runner to third; other out at second; A-2B PO-SS A-SS PO-1B
- 25—Double play; one runner to third; other out at second; A-SS PO-2B A-2B PO-1B
- 26—Infield fly; PO-2B
- 27—Double play; one runner to second; other out at third; PO-3B A-3B PO-1B (X-SO; PO-C)
- 28—Double play; A-SS PO-2B A-2B PO-1B; runner to third
- 29—Double play; one runner to third; A-P PO-SS A-SS PO-1B *A-P PO-1B
- 30—Fly out; runners hold; PO-LF

† On player cards with Double Columns, score this the same as No. 5 — a triple.

When the third out of an inning is recorded on a tag play (at third, second or first) while a run scores (example No. 16* in Fielding Three above), the run is always assumed to have crossed the plate BEFORE the tag at the other base. The run therefore, DOES count.

For board numbers 21, 22, 24, 25, 29, 33 and 34, determine proper fielding column as follows: if the four infielders, the pitcher and catcher (6 players only) total less than 30, use Fielding No. 3; 30 to 34 inclusive, Fielding No. 2; 35 or more, use Fielding No. 1.

On all other board numbers (12, 13, 14, 23 and 35 to 42 inclusive), use the full team fielding rating as described in the fielding instructions under the BASES EMPTY section of the playing boards.
