

# HIT AND RUN PLAY—Runner On First

- 1—HOMERUN to deep right center field
- 2—TRIPLE to right; batter out at home; A-RF A-2B PO-C
- 3—DOUBLE to center; runner scores; batter to third on throw home (S out at home; A-CF PO-C)
- 4—SINGLE through second; runner to third
- 5—SINGLE to center; runner to third (F scores)
- 6—DOUBLE to right; runner scores
- 7—SINGLE to right; runner to third (AGAINST GRADE A, A & C or A & B PITCHERS; same as No. 28 below)
- 8—Same as Regular Playing Board. Observe pitcher's grade
- 9—SINGLE though short; runner to third (AGAINST A, A & C, A & B, B or C PITCHERS, same as No. 26 below)
- 10—SINGLE though 2nd; runner to 3rd; batter steals 2nd on 3rd pitch to next batter; 1 ball, 2 strikes (AGAINST A, A & C, A & B, B or C PITCHERS, same as No. 26 below)
- 11—SINGLE to center; runner to 3rd; batter steals 2nd on 4th pitch to next batter; 2 balls, 2 strikes (AGAINST A, A & C, A & B or B PITCHERS, same as No. 28 below)
- 12—Out at first; runner to second; A-2B PO-1B
- 13—Strike—runner out stealing; A-C PO-SS; IF RUNNER HAS AN ELEVEN ON CARD, HE STEALS SAFELY [*† See Below*]
- 14—Ball—runner out stealing; A-C PO-SS; IF RUNNER HAS A TEN OR ELEVEN ON CARD, HE STEALS SAFELY
- 15—Hit by Pitcher; batter to first; runner to second
- 16—SINGLE over second; runner to third
- 17—SINGLE to right; runner to third
- 18—Out at first; runner to second; A-SS PO-1B
- 19—Hit by Pitcher; batter to first; runner to second
- 20—Out at first; runner to second; A-2B PO-1B
- 21—Strike—runner out stealing; A-C PO-2B
- 22—Runner caught off first; A-P PO-1B
- 23—Ball—runner out stealing; A-C PO-SS
- 24—Out at first; runner to second; A-2B PO-1B
- 25—Double play; line drive; PO-RF A-RF PO-1B
- 26—Out at first; runner to second; A-2B PO-1B
- 27—Out at first; runner to second; A-3B PO-1B
- 28—Out at first; runner to second; A-SS PO-1B
- 29—Out at first; runner to second; A-P PO-1B
- 30—Fly out; runner holds; PO-LF
- 31—SINGLE to right center; runner to third
- 32—Fly out; runner holds; PO-RF
- 33—Double play; line drive; PO-3B A-3B PO-1B
- 34—Double play; line drive; PO-SS A-SS PO-1B
- 35—Strike—runner out stealing; A-C PO-SS
- 36—Stolen base and wild pitch; runner to third
- 37—Runner caught off first; A-P PO-1B
- 38—Ball—runner steals second
- 39—Strike—runner out stealing; A-C PO-2B
- 40—SINGLE through second; runner to third
- 41—SINGLE through first; runner to third
- 42—SINGLE through first; runner to third

†On No. 13 (this page) and Nos. 13 and 14 (following page), the runner on first steals safely only if he has an eleven in the first column of his player card. Disregard second column 11's in these cases.

**IMPORTANT:** When numbers 7, 8 and/or 11 appear in the second column of a player card, they are NOT subject to the grade changes described above. When these numbers come up in the second column, treat them as though a Grade D Pitcher is pitching. This is true for all base situations.
