

RUNNERS ON SECOND AND THIRD BASES

(Squeeze Play)

- 1—Out at 1st; runners advance one base; A-3B PO-2B†
- 2—Out at 1st; runners advance one base; A-1B PO-2B†
- 3—Out at 1st; runners advance one base; A-3B PO-1B†
- 4—Out at 1st; runners advance one base; A-1B PO-2B†
- 5—Out at 1st; runners advance one base; A-P PO-2B†
- 6—SINGLE—bunt in front of home plate; batter beats out catcher's throw; other runners hold safely
- 7—Out at 1st; runners advance one base; A-3B PO-1B†
- 8—Out at 1st; runners advance one base; A-1B PO-2B†
- 9—SINGLE—beats out bunt; runners advance one base
- 10—SINGLE—beats out bunt; runners advance one base
- 11—SINGLE—beats out bunt; runners advance one base
- 12—Double play; bunt fly out; PO-3B A-3B PO-SS; runner on third is out; other holds at second
- 13—Strike—runner out at home; other to third; PO-C
- 14—Hit by pitcher; filling the bases
- 15—Out at 1st; runners advance one base; A-3B PO-2B†
- 16—Foul strike
- 17—Out at 1st; runners advance one base; PO-P†
- 18—First on error; runners advance one base; catcher fumbles short bunt; E-C†
- 19—First on error; runners advance one base; fumbled bunt; E-3B†
- 20—Strike—runners hold
- 21—First and second on error; both runners score; wild throw to second baseman covering first; E-1B†
- 22—First on error; runners advance one base; fumbled bunt; E-P†
- 23—Double play; runner out at home in rundown; other out trying for third; batter to second; A-C PO-SS PO-SS
- 24—Ball—runner out at home; other to third; PO-C
- 25—Strike—runner out at home; other to third; PO-C
- 26—Out at 1st; runners advance one base; A-1B PO-2B†
- 27—Foul strike
- 28—Foul strike
- 29—Strike—runners hold safely
- 30—Out at 1st; runners advance one base; A-3B PO-1B†
- 31—Out at 1st; runners advance one base; A-1B PO-2B†
- 32—Foul strike

- 36—Wild pitch; runners advance one base
- 37—Catcher picks runner off third base; A-C PO-3B

- 41—Balk—runners advance one base
- 42—Hit by pitcher; filling the bases

If the run scoring constitutes the winning run and it is the home half of the last inning, do not record any fielding credit. In such an instance there would be no play for the batter at first. Credit the batter with a SINGLE on such a play.
