

RUNNER ON FIRST AND SECOND BASES

Grade B Pitcher

- 1 HOMERUN over right field fence
- 2 HOMERUN to extreme right field (2nd Col, see #5)
- 3 DOUBLE to deep center; runners score; (S on 1st out at home; A-CF A-SS PO-C)
- 4 HOMERUN over right field fence
- 5 TRIPLE to right field bull pen
- 6 DOUBLE to left center; runners score (S on 1st out at home; A-LF A-SS PO-C)
- 7 SINGLE to left; one scores (S out at home & batter to 2nd; A-LF PO-C); other to 3rd
- 8 Out at 1st; runner advance one base; A-3B PO-1B
- 9 SINGLE - beats out infield hit; fills the bases
- 10 Out at 1st; A-P PO-1B; runners advance one base
- 11 SINGLE over 2nd; one runner scores; other to 3rd; batter steals second on next pitch; one ball on batter

FIELDING ONE

- 12 Batter safe at 1st on FC; one runner out at 2nd; other safe at 3rd; A-SS; PO-2B (W-base on balls)
- 13 Strikeout; PO-C
- 14 Base on balls; fills the bases (Z or ZZ: 2 balls)
- 15 SINGLE to left; one runner scores; other to 3rd; batter out trying for 2nd; A-LF A-1B PO-2B
- 16 1st on error; runner out at home; other to 3rd; batter to 2nd on throw home; E-CF A-CF PO-C; *one runner scores; other out at 3rd; E-CF A-CF PO-3B
- 17 Hit by pitcher; fills the bases
- 18 SINGLE thru short; runners advance 2 bases; (S on 1st out at 3rd; A-CF PO-3B)
- 19 1st on error; runners advance 2 bases; E-3B
- 20 1st on error; filling the bases; E-2B
- 21 Out at 1st; runners advance 1 base; A-3B E-1B
- 22 1st on error; filling the bases; E-P
- 23 Foul; strike; catcher injured by foul tip and is unable to play in next 3 games
- 24 Double Play; one runner to 3rd; other out at 2nd; A-2B PO-SS A-SS PO-1B
- 25 Double Play; one runner to 3rd; other out at 2nd; A-SS PO-2B A-2B PO-1B
- 26 Infield fly; PO-2B (K-SO; PO-C)
- 27 Double Play; one runner to 2nd; other out at 3rd; PO-3B A-3B PO-1B (K-SO PO-C)
- 28 Double Play; runner to 3rd; A-SS PO-2B A-2B PO-1B
- 29 Double Play; one runner to 3rd; A-P PO-SS A-SS PO-1B; *A-P PO-1B
- 30 Fly out; runners hold; PO-LF (K-SO; PO-C)
- 31 Fly out; runners hold; PO-CF
- 32 Fly out; runners hold; PO-RF (K-SO; PO-C)
- 33 Infield fly; PO-SS
- 34 Infield fly; PO-3B (K-SO; PO-C)
- 35 Foul out; PO-C (W-Base on balls)
- 36 Passed ball; runners advance 1 base
- 37 Double steal; runners advance 1 base
- 38 Out at 1st; runners advance one base; A-1B PO-P; pitcher injured covering 1st; out for remainder of game
- 39 Double play; fly out; PO-CF; runner out at 3rd; other holds; A-CF PO-3B (F safe at 3rd)
- 40 Safe on error; filling the bases; A-SS E-2B
- 41 Triple play; line drive; PO-2B PO-2B A-2B PO-1B
- 42 Hit by pitcher; fills the bases

Grade A Pitcher

- 1 HOMERUN over right field fence
- 2 HOMERUN to extreme right field (2nd Col, see #5)
- 3 DOUBLE to deep center; runners score; (S on 1st out at home; A-CF A-SS PO-C)
- 4 HOMERUN over right field fence
- 5 TRIPLE to right field bull pen
- 6 DOUBLE to left center; runners score (S on 1st out at home; A-LF A-SS PO-C)
- 7 SINGLE to left; one scores (S out at home & batter to 2nd; A-LF PO-C); other to 3rd
- 8 Out at 1st; runner advance one base; A-3B PO-1B
- 9 Out at 1st; runner advance one base; A-P PO-1B
- 10 Out at 1st; runner advance one base; PO-1B
- 11 SINGLE over 2nd; one runner scores; other to 3rd; batter steals second on next pitch; one ball on batter

When the third out of an inning is recorded on a tag play (at third, second or first) while a run scores (example: No. 16* in Fielding Three), the run is always assumed to have crossed the plate BEFORE the tag occurred at the other base. The run, therefore, DOES count.
