

BASES LOADED

Grade B Pitcher

- 1 HOMERUN to deep center field
- 2 TRIPLE to extreme left field
- 3 TRIPLE to right field
- 4 DOUBLE to left center; runners advance 2 bases; * 3 runners score
- 5 DOUBLE to right; 3 runners score (S on 1st out at home; A-RF PO-C
- 6 TRIPLE over third (2nd Col., see #4)
- 7 SINGLE over 2nd; 2 runners score; other to 2nd (F to 3rd)
- 8 Fly out; 1 runner scores; others hold; PO-CF; *SO PO-C
- 9 SINGLE over 1st; runners advance 1 base *runners advance 2 bases
- 10 SINGLE over 3rd; runners advance 2 bases; batter steals 2nd on next pitch; 1 ball on batter
- 11 SINGLE past 2nd; runners advance 2 bases; batter steals second on third pitch to next batter; 3 balls on batter

Grade A Pitcher

- HOMERUN to deep center field
- TRIPLE to extreme left field
- TRIPLE to right field
- DOUBLE to left center; runners advance 2 bases; * 3 runners score
- DOUBLE to right; 3 runners score (S on 1st out at home; A-RF PO-C
- TRIPLE over third (2nd Col., see #4)
- SINGLE over 2nd; 2 runners score; other to 2nd (F to 3rd)
- Fly out; 1 runner scores; others hold; PO-RF
- Fly out; runner scores; others hold; PO-CF *SO PO-C
- SINGLE over 3rd; runners advance 2 bases; batter steals 2nd on next pitch; 1 ball on batter
- SINGLE past 2nd; runners advance 2 bases; batter steals second on third pitch to next batter; 3 balls on batter

FIELDING ONE

- 12 C-DP; runner out at home; batter out at 1st; A-SS PO-C A-C PO-1B D-DP; batter out at 1st; runner out at 2nd; others advance 1 base; A-SS PO-2B A-2B PO-1B
- 13 Strikeout; PO-C
- 14 Base on balls (Z or ZZ Pitcher: 2 balls)
- 15 SINGLE to left; runners advance 2 bases; (S on 2nd out at home; A-LF PO-C)
- 16 SINGLE to center; runners advance 2 bases; batter out trying for 2nd; A-CF A-1B PO-2B
- 17 SINGLE to right; runners advance 1 base; *runners advance 2 bases
- 18 1st on error; runners advance one base; E-SS
- 19 Out at 1st; runners advance 1 base; A-3B PO-1B
- 20 Hit by pitcher; runners advance 1 base
- 21 C-1st on error-fumbled grounder; runners advance 1 base; E-1B D-1st on E-1B; runners advance 1 base
- 22 C-Catcher picks runner off 1st; A-C PO-1B D-DP; line drive, both PO-SS
- 23 C-Hit by pitcher; batter to 1st D-Out at 1st; runners advance 1 base; A-1B PO-P
- 24 C-DP; runner out at home; batter out at 1st; A-SS PO-C A-C PO-1B D-DP; runner out at 2nd; batter out at 1st; others advance 1 base; A-SS PO-2B A-2B PO-1B
- 25 DP; runner out at home, batter out at 1st; A-P PO-C A-C PO-1B; *A-P PO-1B
- 26 C-Safe at 1st; FC; runner out at home; A-2B PO-C D-DP; runner out at 2nd; batter out at 1st; others advance 1 base; A-2B PO-SS A-SS PO-1B
- 27 DP; runner out at home; batter out at 1st; A-3B PO-C A-C PO-1B; *PO-3B (X-SO PO-C)
- 28 C-SINGLE to short; runners advance 1 base D-Batter safe at 1st; FC; runner out at 2nd; others advance 1 base; A-SS PO-2B
- 29 Batter safe at 1st; FC; runner forced out at home; others advance; 1 base; A-P PO-C; *A-P PO-1B (Y-SO; PO-C)
- 30 Fly out; runners hold; PO-LF (X-SO; PO-C)
- 31 Fly out; runners hold; PO-CF
- 32 Fly out; runners on 2nd & 3rd advance 1 base; other holds; PO-RF (K-SO; PO-C)
- 33 Infield fly; PO-1B; runners hold (K-SO; PO-C)
- 34 Fly out; one scores; others hold; PO-LF (Y-SO; PO-C)
- 35 Strikeout; PO-C (W-Base on balls)
- 36 Wild pitch; runners advance 1 base
- 37 Fly out; all runners advance 1 base; PO-CF
- 38 Infield fly; batter out; PO-SS; shortstop loses ball in sun; runners advance 1 base; *SINGLE; runners advance 1 base
- 39 Runner out stealing home; other advance 1 base; PO-C
- 40 C-SINGLE-Pitcher hit by line drive; runners advance 1 base D-Base on balls
- 41 Triple play; PO-SS PO-SS A-SS PO-3B
- 42 Hit by pitcher; runners advance 1 base

With third base occupied and less than two out, the defensive manager must announce whether his infield is “deep” or “in.” If he fails to do so, it is considered to be “deep.”
